

A planning meeting of the Parish Council took place on Monday, 26th September 2016 at 6.30pm in the Village Hall.

Present: Cllr Abu-Hejleh, Cllr Whitmore and the clerk. Cllr Cushing sent a full response as he could not attend.

As this was an extraordinary meeting to discuss a planning application, no minutes were read, nor other business considered.

**Proposal: Variation of conditions 3 (details of reserved matters) and 11 (flood risk asset register), and Removal of Conditions 4,5,6,7 and 8 of Planning permission DC/16/1280/OUT. (Outline planning application for an area of new employment and commercial buildings at Bentwaters).
Address: Bentwaters Business Park, Rendlesham.**

Bentwaters Park had no option but to submit an application, in order to formally remove and vary conditions erroneously and invalidly applied by SCDC to the outline consent already granted, and seemingly “lifted” directly from another consent in a different area.

Councillors present agreed with Cllr Cushing's assessment that there is no comment to make, as OPP has already been granted, but just to underline that this is a serious error by SCDC planning department.
