

A planning meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday, 20th February 2017 at 6.30pm in the Village Hall.

Present: Cllr. Abu-Hejleh, Cllr. Cushing, Cllr. Whitmore and the clerk.

As this was an extraordinary meeting to discuss a planning application, no minutes were read not other business considered.

Planning application:

Proposal: DC/17/0284/VOC. Variation of condition 2 of planning consent DC/14/3053/FUL. Erection of one, one and a half storey dwelling. – Reduction in build area, resulting in changes to fenestration. In complete accordance with drawing nos: 120117 parts 1,2 & 3.

Location: Part rear garden, The Old House, The Street, Eyke.

A letter of objection from Mrs Gallina, specifically in relation to the windows overlooking her property at Linden Rise was read.

While having some sympathy with her situation, it was agreed that there were no grounds on which the Parish Council could specifically object. Permission had been granted two years ago, and the variation being sought will result in a smaller build area.

It was agreed, however, to point out in the Parish Council response that although there are no grounds for refusal, it is hoped that SCDC will bear the objections in mind when considering the application.
