

A meeting of the Parish Council took place on Monday, 25th January 2021 at 6.30pm via Zoom video conferencing.

Present: Cllrs. Abu-Hejleh, Clark, Cushing, Stangoe and the clerk.

There were no apologies for absence.

As this was an extraordinary meeting to discuss a planning application, no minutes were read, nor other business considered.

Planning Application: DC/20/5278/FUL.

Land to the North and West of Garden Square and Gardenia Close, Rendlesham, Suffolk.

Proposal: A phased development of 75 dwellings, car parking, public open space, hard and soft landscaping, and associated infrastructure and access.

A previous application for 75 dwellings on this site was rejected on appeal last year. Councillors agreed that the impact on Eyke in terms of traffic would be the same with the current application, and therefore objected again on the same terms.

DC/20/3890/OUT. This is an outline application for 75 dwellings and associated open space, including community orchards and allotments along with play space and integrated public rights of way, on land off Redwald Road, Rendlesham. It appears that local bodies and individuals were not consulted about this application as they had been previously, and the Parish Council agreed that a complaint and objection should be submitted now.
